

We also read Oi Frog! which the children loved. We have been making frog lifecycle headbands, painting pictures of tadpoles, froglets and frogspawn as well as frog puppets. The children can't wait to share all of this with you at the café.



## Maths

We have been counting beyond 20, I have said a number and then the children have said the next number. We have looked at shape pictures and named the 2D and 3D shapes in them. We have also used positional language to describe where the cubes are within a model.
