

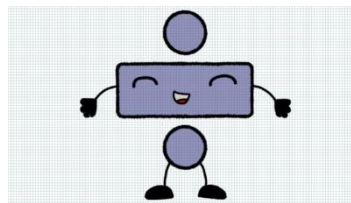


Year 2 - WB 14.11.22

Science

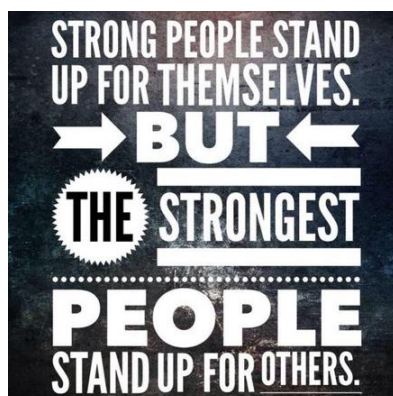
