

WHAT HAVE WE BEEN LEARNING IN DIAMOND CLASS? WB 01.02.16



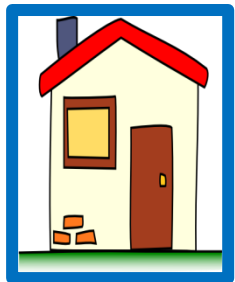
This week we have been learning about the British Values. We have focussed on rule of law and individual liberty. We spoke about what rules we have in school, what rules we have within our classroom and what rules adults have in the big wide world. The children really enjoyed speaking about rules adults have to follow such as traffic signals.



This week we have been doing lots of phonics work. We have been working so hard on our listening and attention skills to ensure we are ready to learn. We have been working hard on learning how to differentiate words and pictures by their initial sound. We sorted out three sets of objects by the sounds, 's' 'a' and 't'.



This week we finished our story map of the three little pigs. The children have enjoyed this process so much and it has great value – they have learnt the story of the three little pigs, the language is embedded into their vocabulary, which they will use in their drama and role play and in their reading and writing as they get older. The children will be bringing a copy of the story map home to read to/with you. We hope you enjoy it!
