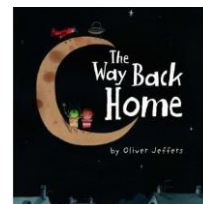


Ruby news

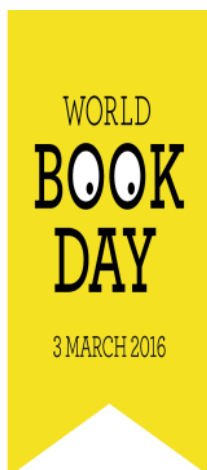
English- In English we have continued with our space story. This week we have focussed on noun phrases which is where you extend the noun by describing it in more detail for example, the grass could become the green, long grass.
