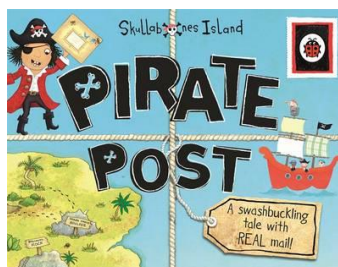
Maths –
