English – This week we have finished our ‘Wall-E/Robots’ topic. The children have made their robots, sent a message to Wall-E and feel they have really helped him. We kick started our next terms topic of ‘A twist in time’ with a performance from a theatre company. It was brilliant, giving the children a glimpse into how life was different in the past. This generated some fantastic questions from the children, which I will be incorporating into next terms plans.

Math’s – We have been learning our number bonds to ten e.g $6+4=10$, $8+2=10$ etc. The children have been brilliant at learning them and applying these facts to their adding. Youtube has some great videos/songs for helping the children to learn them. (please don’t allow your child unsupervised access to Youtube though!)

Phonics - We have been looking at Phase 3 sounds this week, concentrating on ***air, ear and ure***. The children have worked incredibly hard on these trigraphs as they are very tricky ones! We have also looked at the tricky words ***all, was and are***.

Topic – You may have heard the children mention ‘SQUILT’ time. This stands for Super Quiet Uninterrupted Listening Time. Music is a passion of both Mine and Mrs Spelman’s so we have been sharing a range of music with the children and talking about the era it comes from and how it makes them feel.
