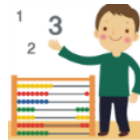
Maths

- 5th January 2017: Children return to school



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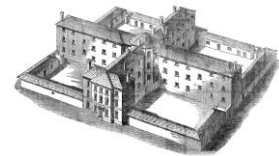
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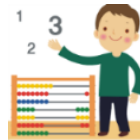
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
