

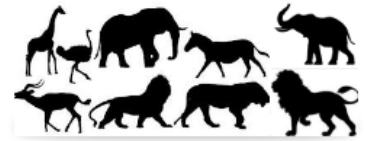

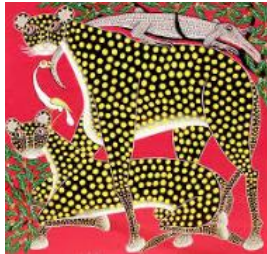
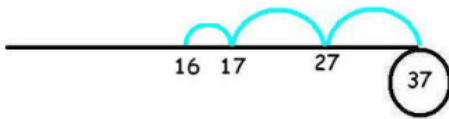
In English we have continued with report writing. This week though we have been writing reports about animals of Africa. We have been learning lots of different interesting facts about a range of different African animals.
