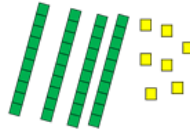
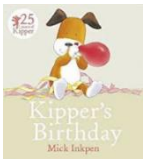


English

Maths

In maths this week we have continued to practise partitioning numbers. As well as tens and ones, we have also thought about how else we can partition numbers:

$$24 = 20 + 4$$

$$24 = 18 + 6$$

$$24 = 12 + 12$$

$$24 = 15 + 9$$

$$24 = 22 + 2$$

$$24 = 16 + 8$$

We have also been thinking about the commutative law of addition. Addition can be done in any order:

$$8 + 2 = 10 \text{ and } 2 + 8 = 10$$
