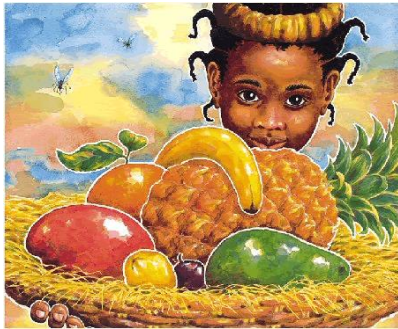


Emerald Class Weekly News
