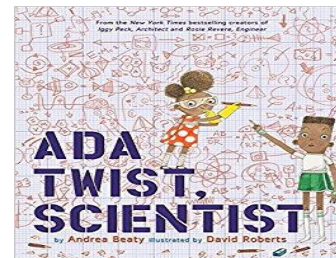


May the 4th be with you
