**English** – This week we have completed our stories and gone through the children's English targets, which were also discussed in Time to Talk.

We have also spent time perfecting our acting, dancing and singing skills!

**Math's** – This week we have been consolidating all of the skills we have learnt this term. The children particularly enjoyed making up their own subtraction stories e.g. There were 11 dinosaurs, 7 went to sleep. How many are awake? Answers on a postcard ☺

In phonics we have been exploring another split digraph... e\_e. The children have been brilliant at making links to their prior knowledge of split digraphs and applying this to the e\_e digraph. We spend a great deal of time talking about our learning skills, this includes being explicit about their thinking skills. We often talk about our neurons, pathways and having a colourful brain rather than a grey brain.

Time to Talk. We hope you are finding this a useful time to find out how well your child is doing, where their learning is currently, where they need to get to and how we, as a team, are going to get them there. It's always a pleasure sharing their learning with you, we have found that having the children there is powerful and gives us a point of reference with the children.
