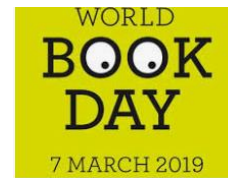

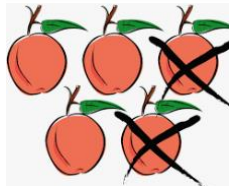

Phonics

We have been learning the sounds **ai, ee, oa, or, ear, air, ure, igh** this week and revising words from set 10, 11 and 12.

After half term we are revising the sounds: **ch, sh, th, ng** and the words from set 13: **have, went, then, were, go.**

The children are really trying hard with their writing, why not try being segmenting superheroes at home and seeing what sounds your child can stretch out of a word to write it?

Maths

This week in maths we completed our work with addition. We were adding 2 groups together and recording our answers.

When we return after half term we are learning about 1 more and 1 less. We also will practise counting reliably, and be able to count on and back from different starting points, not just 0 or 1.
