English

We have been focusing on non-fiction this week. The children have written an informative piece of writing all about sheep. They have focused on the features of a non-fiction texts including sub-headings and labelled pictures. Some have challenged themselves to extend their writing by adding conjunctions.



Maths

In maths this week we have been practising applying our multiplication and division skills to word problems. The children have been great at picking out the language of the question to see if they should multiply or divide, and they've managed to solve these word problems using arrays and sharing.

Science

We have been experimenting with paper helicopters this week. The children have led this experiment by choosing what they would change about their helicopter and what they should measure. We've had helicopters of all shapes and sizes, and the children have been measuring things like how long the helicopter takes to fall and the accuracy of the landing.
