

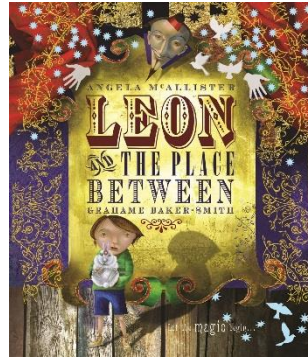


Coral Class – WB 02.05.19



English

We have continuing our work with the book 'Leon and the place between' this week. The children have written a diary entry from Leon's point of view, writing about what Leon saw and did in the place between. They made sure that their diary was all written in the past tense and used a variety of different time conjunctions. The children also compared formal and informal language.



Maths

This week in maths we have been practising our multiplication skills. The children have used both arrays and counted up in intervals to work out multiplication calculations. They then applied these skills to some tricky word problems.

We are finding that many of our children are a little fussy with their food, and are not liking some of the options. We feel that we need to tell you about this to make sure you select an alternative option. To make this system easy we have decided that if a child hasn't eaten much and doesn't like it they will be given a little slip, on yellow paper, that says 'Ask me about my lunch today'

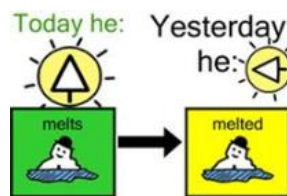


Circus workshop
