Wed 24th July-last day of term-break up for Summer

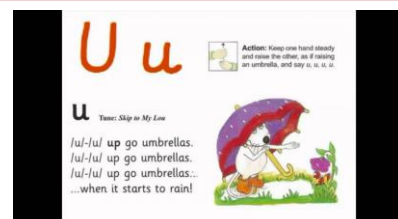
We have been creating our own 'bog babies' using various media including blue cakes! We have tried to use clues about what he looked like from the story.
