Transition

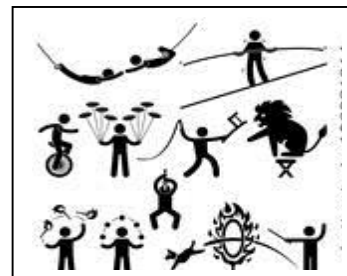
