

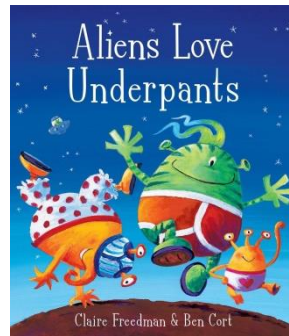


Coral Class – WB 06.01.20

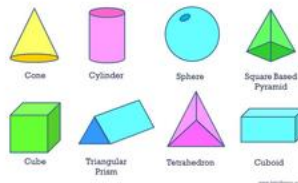


English

The children have been working with lots of impactful adjective and we have challenged them to use these in a simile, for example orange like satsumas and as fluffy as a rabbit. We have used this story as inspiration to write our own stories *Aliens love socks!* The children have done really well in applying their similes to their own stories.

Maths

In Maths this week we have been looking at lots of different shapes and their properties. We have learned new vocabulary to describe a shape's vertices (corners), edges, and faces. The children have used this vocabulary to describe shapes, identify shapes, and picked which shape is the odd one out.

Topic

This week we have begun to look at our new topic – SPACE! We looked at the first moon landing and Neil Armstrong's role on Apollo 11. In science we learned the planets in our solar system and a mnemonic to help us remember the order they are from the Sun. We looked at the scale of space and our Earth in comparison to the Sun and other planets in our solar system.
