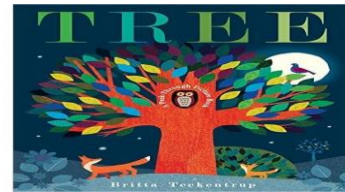

Wed 15th Dec Wear a Christmas jumper to Nursery day

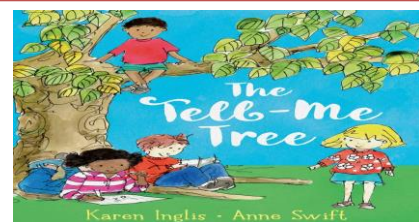
Th 16th Dec- last day of term
