

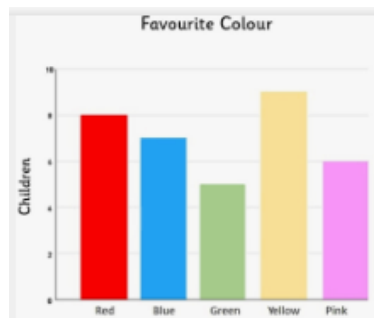


# Year 2 - WB 20.6.22



## English

This week we have been thinking about how the Year 1 children might be feeling nervous about Year 2, so we wrote leaflets explaining all the wonderful things about our experience.
