

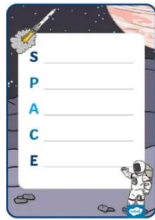
Year One News

English

It was World Poetry Day on Tuesday, so to celebrate this, we shared lots of poems in class and wrote our own acrostic poem about space. We made sure that we described space, using the correct letter to start each line and we included lots of wonderful adjectives. Our challenge this week was to also include alliteration and/or similes.



Phonics

This week in Phonics we have recapped over the sounds: wh, are, kn, wr, ph and au. We will continue to recap over the sounds from before half term to fill any gaps.

Maths... This week in Maths we recapped on length using the vocabulary of longer/shorter and longest/shortest. We also ordered objects by their length and measured different lengths using cubes and other classroom objects. We also looked at positional language and used the vocabulary of forwards, backwards, left, right, up and down to direct teddy bears around a grid to avoid obstacles.

Geography

Following on from our visit from Adrian Hall last week, we have been continuing to look at maps. We recapped on what an aerial or birds eye view is and looked at aerial photographs to help us to create our own map of the school field. We also had a go at adding a key.
