Phonics

In phonics this week we have recapped the sounds: ear, or, tch, dge, er and looked at the other spellings that we already know for these sounds too.

Maths

This week in maths we were learning about finding the difference to help with subtracting and we looked at number fact families e.g. 7+5=12, 5+7=12, 12-7=5, 12-5=7.
